President's message -

I want to use a large portion of this platform to try to touch on two issues that we get a lot of questions about.

#1 – How donations are used and #2 - endowment explanation.

#1 - To be perfectly honest, I'm still trying to understand this enough to articulate it back to you. Nancy Cunningham, Class of '65, is our person in the know. Nancy is our current Vice President and Alumni Association representative of the LCN board. She has been dealing with this for many years.

The words: donation, principal, endowment fund, base principal, investment income, spending rate policy, and perpetuity are about to occupy some real estate in your brain. Buckle up and hang on. I'm about to take your synapses for a ride!

For many years your general, scholarship and memorial donations were given to the Lakeview Alumni Association and by extension to the Lakeview College of Nursing who established an endowment fund to protect and grow your donations for perpetuating the education of future nurses.

The principal (base amount set aside to establish the endowment) is invested and remains untouched, while the investment income (earnings) is used to support the designated purpose of the endowment.

A spending rate policy established by the "corporation" (LCN) determines how much of the investment income can be used annually (typically, a designated percent), while the rest remains invested to maintain and grow the principal.

Endowments are often designed to last indefinitely (perpetuity), with the principal being kept intact while the earnings are used to support the organization's mission over time; thus building assets for future sustainability.

Did you make it this far with me? Now you have the foundation for the remaining comments.

In the past two years the alumni association has been able to donate \$8000 to the endowment fund, due to your generosity. So, the amount of interest earned was higher than past years; therefore, the amount of the scholarships went up a couple of hundred dollars this year. This amount varies from year to year according to the current interest rates, which aren't very high right now.

Just as a reminder of the criteria to receive a Lakeview Alumni Scholarship - a student must be the family member of a LVMH graduate/alumni, enrolled full time, in freshman year at LCN, grade point average of 4.0-5.0, community involvement, demonstrates leadership and is merit based. The scholarship is to be used for tuition and books. Then LCN chooses the student and sets the amount based on the information above – (we, the alumni association are not involved in the choosing process).

I hope this sheds a little "light" on a confusing subject. Now, go back and reread this a couple of times to see if the 20/40 watt understanding has brightened to at least an 80/100 watt understanding.

#2 - The other big issue the all-inclusive alumni banquet. No one wants this more than your alumni board and alumni association members – trust me on this!!!! We have been beating our heads against a brick wall for three years trying to find a way back! Every rabbit trail ends in a dead end.

The main problem – The venues require that we commit to 100 people in attendance – or we pay for the difference/balance. Remember this arrangement must be made one year in advance – we don't have commitments one year in advance! Stay with me for response statistics.

How many of you want to contribute to that bottomless fund if we don't have a good response the following year? Consider the risk of 20-30 unpaid meals (lack of registrations) at \$30-35 per meal (Beef House prices) – that's a possible \$600-\$1000 loss!!!!?! We can't just pick another \$1000 off the alumni money tree.

This year we had a wonderfully large response for the Class of '75 50-year luncheon - 21+ classmates attending, plus the alumni association board.

When I get done you will say TMI (too much information) – but you need to understand the reality.

This year we had 157 responses out of the entire history of LVMH & LCN. Do you think each and every alumni – without exception – is going to show up at our banquet next year. I don't hardly think so! (Thinking about the 100 minimum requirement for most venues.)

Let me digress with the total responses from each decade this year: 40's (2) – 50's (18) – 60's (67) – 70's (61) – 80's (5) – 90's (3) – 2000-2024, 2.5 decades (1). Full disclosure the 90's decade = actually 8 responses - 5 previous LVMH who were also BSN and 3 BSN only grads). FYI - the 90's to present statistics are the normal response for the last several years.

Now let's look forward at just the responses from the future 50-year celebrations: 1976 (2) – 1977 (3) – 1978 (2) – 1979 (3) – 1980 (0) – 1981 (2) – 1982/83/84 (1 each) 1985/86/87/88/89 (0 response each).

These numbers give you an insight into possible future class interest in 50-year celebrations. I have class rosters for '76, '77, '78 and '79. I am currently working on finding and confirming contact information for the class of '76 and will continue the other classes through the summer. It's never too early to start the process!

Here's my theory - Up until 1990 we lived in a dorm, we shared life, we built relationships / extended families. Truth be told, full class in the dorm life started falling apart by the time I graduated in 1970. Some of our class members were assigned small groups in an apartment building. Then, after the dorm was no more, students came to class straight from home each day and returned to their homes until the next class day. There was no building a "family relationship" with other students. Many students were married with families to be responsible for at home. Nursing changed from a vocation (a calling to serve) to a well-paying career path from which to springboard to a higher education and higher paying career (which isn't bad in itself). This, I feel, has a tremendous basis for the low response from 1990-2024. This is not a criticism – it's just a reality check.

Full disclosure – I was reminded that dues letters were only mailed this year to the Class of '85 and backwards to the 40's. Before anyone gets upset about that, review the statistics above. When you look at the above statistics you can imagine the cost of mailing dues letters to 1990-2024 - 34 years of students with the above response – at \$.75 per mailing. What would that be? ...34 years (1990-2024) at 15 students per year (very low-ball estimate) would be valued at 510 students x \$.75 = \$382.50 just for stamps alone for an average 4 responses.

We are open for functional ideas; maybe venues that don't require the 100-person minimum. Let us know of such places. We are trying to investigate use of electronic communication. H-E-L-P!!! In the meantime, please know that you are not alone in your frustration and we are truly trying to make the all-inclusive banquet a reality again.

For other news, please refer to "letter from president" that accompanied your dues letter. I've run out of my allotted space for this year!

Lakeview Alumni, Thanks so much for all the work you do to keep the Alumni informed and "together." The memories there at LVMH go back 74 years when I was in an auto accident which left me with a fractured pelvis in 4 places. It happened the end of May, so it was a long summer in a hospital bed at home. But, I was there in the hospital for 2 weeks and I observed the nurses. They were very patient and gave me the most loving care, for which I never forgot.

So, when it came time for high school graduation and deciding what I would do with the rest of my life – I could think of nothing besides nursing. My parents had moved to Indiana by then, but I decided to come back to LVMH for my nurses training. Three wonderful years of great experiences and memories.

Part of our training included 3 months of training at Cook County in Chicago. I was scared to death to go to Chicago! But the Lord took care of us, and we experienced some unique medical situations. When I graduated in 1962, I really felt lead to return to Chicago and Cook County Hospital!!!! I applied for a promotion to the O.R.; however, when I got there, they assigned me to the 60-bed "recovery room" – which was a really large ICU with 30 beds for surgical ICU and 30 beds for medical ICU. I saw and helped care for patients in situations I would never experience anywhere else! They had a lot of Filipino nurses, and they encouraged me to go to England for their midwifery program. I would encourage any nurse who is thinking of working O.B. to go to England for that experience!!! It is a one-year program – part 1 in the hospital and part 2 in the district. (home deliveries and care). Returning to the USA, I worked in Indianapolis for the next 10 years in ICU. In 1974 I met my "husband-to-be" and moved to Bowling Green, MO which was John's hometown. I had been on 3 medical mission trips to Honduras before I met John. (The Christian Medical Society has mission trips, continuously (year-round) to a lot of countries.)
